Remember to choose sources that are of personal interest to your own development; these sources may even be of help in future research classes related to your major area of study. The Bibliography is an important part of

the PASSport project because it represents the possibilities for future exploration and the discovery of new knowledge. Practically speaking, it also gives you the chance to become comfortable with APA style citations. The sooner you master APA style, the less difficulty you will have in future courses that rely upon this important skill.

This is also the last week you will have a "required" contact with your success coach. Use this opportunity to make sure you are ready for the next session (registered for classes? books ordered?), and then establish an expectation for how you will interact with your coach going forward. You have lots of available support at our university, and your Success Coach will remain a crucial aspect of your own strategy for success throughout the remainder of your degree program.
